

Mitered Edges & Mitered Sinks

What Is a Mitered Edge?

A mitered edge sink instantly creates a luxurious and expensive feel and become focal point of the design.

A mitered edge is created when the corners of two slabs are cut to a 45-degree angle to seamlessly join together. This type of edge is useful to incorporate a custom trough sink. It is important to note while the the edges join seamlessly, it is not possible for veining to line up perfectly.



Mitered sinks do not come in a “standard” size and each are custom designed based on the customer’s preferences. A custom quote is always required. Mitered sinks do require a line drain. It is not included in Premier’s pricing and is to be purchased and installed by the customer/plumber after countertop installation.
