

## Mitered Edges & Mitered Sinks

### *What Is a Mitered Edge?*

A mitered edge sink instantly creates a luxurious and expensive feel and become focal point of the design.

A mitered edge is created when the corners of two slabs are cut to a 45-degree angle to seamlessly join together. This type of edge is useful to incorporate a custom trough sink. It is important to note while the the edges join seamlessly, it is not possible for veining to line up perfectly.



Mitered bath sinks come in a standard size of 16.75" x 11.75" x 7.5" and include a line drain. All other size mitered sinks are custom designed based on the customer's preferences and a custom quote is required. Custom mitered sinks require a drain which is not included in Premier's pricing and is to be purchased and installed by the customer/plumber after countertop installation.
